I thought it would be great to incorporate hand prints into the sound of the week and there are so many you can make, I've given you some examples around the page, but google images is a great tool.

Painting hands (and maybe feet) is a great way to engage with your child. Ask him/her questions during the activity such as, "How does it feel when I paint your fingers/toes?" "What colours can we mix to make orange?" "How many eyes does your goat have?" "How many spots have you put on your giraffe? Let's count them together".



Maybe make a farm yard scene adding in extra animals.



Or get super creative and make hand/foot print animals into puppet show props.
