

E is for Elma the Elephant

Resources – You will need Glue, tissue Paper, a milk bottle, scissors and googly eyes if available.

How to Make Elma the Elephant



1. Find a milk bottle
2. Cut it in half (Maybe a grown up job)
3. Cut out 3 rectangles to make 4 legs.



4. Paste glue over the milk bottle.
5. Use the coloured tissue paper to make Elma look beautiful.



6. Stick eyes on Elma, or draw them on.

An extension of this activity would be to look closer at colours and mix the primary colours (red, yellow and blue).

We often do this as an adult led activity at Preschool and the children are mesmerised that you can make so many different colours out of just 3.
