

# Let's learn the sound of this week

## Pp

Learning the letter Pp can be fun. They are learning to say the sound without even thinking they are .... Popping bubbles and saying pop, pop, pop as they pop them.

You need: Bubble mixture, hoop or anything with a hole in it, tray

Blow the bubbles as high as you can and as they fall encourage your child to pop them. Each time they pop them, emphasise "pop". Your child will copy this repetition time after time.

Talk to your child about whether they can jump to pop them, how far they travel and the different colours you may see in each bubble ..... lots of colours of the rainbow!!!

Your child may also wish to keep the bubbles up and blow them up too. It is a mouth shape that is very useful in speech. You could then ask your child what else 'pops'. Popcorn, mouth, balloons!!!



### Learning objectives:
