

Let's learn the sound of this week

Pp

The letter **Pp** – could be 'p' for **pegs**.

You will need:

A washing line or piece of string

10 Clothes pegs

10 pictures of pink cakes each with corresponding number and candles on.

What to do:

Firstly, hang your washing line up, your child could cut out 10 pink card circles (talk about the shape), write the numbers from 1 – 10 on each cake and see if your child can stick the correct number of candles on each corresponding cake.

Next, see if your child can peg the cakes on the washing line Maybe in the correct order!

As they look at the cakes hung up There is a song you could sing with your child focusing on the sound Pp:

Puff out the candles on the pink, pink cake

Puff out the candles on the pink, pink cake

Puff out the candles on the pink, pink cake,

PUFF, PUFF, PUFF



Learning objectives: Discussing shapes, number recognition and matching number with quantity, number sequencing, fine motor skills including drawing circles, using scissors, manipulating the pegs. And of course focusing on the sound 'P' with a song to learn too.
