

## Silly Soup!



### You will need

- A bowl
- A spoon
- Objects beginning with S to begin with
- To further encourage development find objects that rhyme

Search your house or garden alongside your child looking for objects that will fit into your bowl that begin with the letter Ss, role model language, ask questions and encourage your child to identify objects independently.

Sit together with the objects and the bowl and sing the following song/rhyme as you add each object into your bowl to make a silly soup!

I am going to make a silly soup  
I am making soup that's silly!  
I am going to cook it in the fridge  
To make it nice and chilly!

In goes...



If your child finds this easy, introduce objects that rhyme. Rhyming teaches children how language works, it helps them notice and work with the sounds with the words.
