

# Activity focusing on the letter sounding Bb

## Bb

Bb for **Brown Bear**

**What you need** is a large piece of paper, crayons/pens, circular objects and glue.

### **What you need to do:**

Draw a big B on a large piece of paper ..... show your child your finger moving around the B (down, up and around to form the letter B). Sound the letter sound correctly too. Encourage your child do the same with their finger too. Then explain to them that they need to find some round objects (different sized) ..... order them in size order and then draw around the different sized circle objects and cut them out. These become the bears ears, paws and large feet. Let your child stick them on the B (bear). The bear will become their own design. You could provide textures too.



Extension: You could have some rice in a tray and encourage your child to form some letters with their finger or a pencil in the rice. It's so much fun. Give it a go.

Always remember your pure phonics.
